



Supplier Quality Requirements

A. SUB-TIER CONTROL

The supplier shall be responsible for flow down of all the requirements and provisions of the CNS Aviation purchase order applicable to the supplier's sub-contractors. Additionally, the supplier shall comply with special processor requirements when imposed (e.g. – NADCAP, AMS, Customer approvals, etc.).

B. RIGHT OF ACCESS

During the performance of this purchase order, your Quality Assurance or Inspection and Manufacturing process are subject to review, verification and analysis by CNS Aviation, CNS Aviation customers, and/or Government/Regulatory Agency representative(s). This requirement is applicable to your facilities where CNS Aviation products and services are processed as well as your sub-tier's facilities.

C. SUPPLIER NON-CONFORMANCE APPROVAL REQUESTS

The supplier shall notify CNS Aviation of non-conforming material. Requests for any departures from drawings, specifications, or other purchase order requirements must be submitted for consideration by CNS Aviation in writing. CNS Aviation will in turn either approve or deny approval of the request in writing. *Non-conforming material may NOT be shipped to CNS Aviation without such written approval.* Non-conforming material shipped on an approved non-conformance must be accompanied by a copy of the signed CNS Aviation approval document.

D. RECORDS RETENTION

The Supplier shall maintain adequate records of all aspects of the fulfillment of the purchase order for a period of not less than five (5) years from the closing of the purchase order unless stated otherwise on the purchase order.

E. PROCESS CHANGES

Any changes to the product, process, suppliers, or facility that could impact ability of product to meet CNS Aviation requirements must be communicated to CNS Aviation

F. PRODUCT SAFETY

The organization shall plan, implement, and control the processes needed to assure product safety during the entire product life cycle, as appropriate to the organization and the product.

G. ETHICAL BUSINESS PRACTICES

Contractor, its employees, agents, representatives and Subcontractors shall at all times maintain high ethical standards and avoid conflicts of interest in the conduct of Work for Owner. In conjunction with its performance of the Work, Contractor and its employees, officers, agents and representatives shall comply with, and cause its Subcontractors and their respective employees, officers, agents and representatives to comply with, all Applicable Laws, statutes, regulations and other requirements prohibiting bribery, corruption, kick-backs or similar unethical practices.

H. PRODUCT CONFORMITY

As a supplier to CNS Aviation your commitment to provide quality products and service is paramount to a successful supplier relationship.

H. COUNTERFEIT PREVENTION

Supplier's must have a provision in their QMS to address counterfeit prevention to ensure that counterfeit product/service is not sent or utilized in the performance of a purchase order from CNS Aviation.
